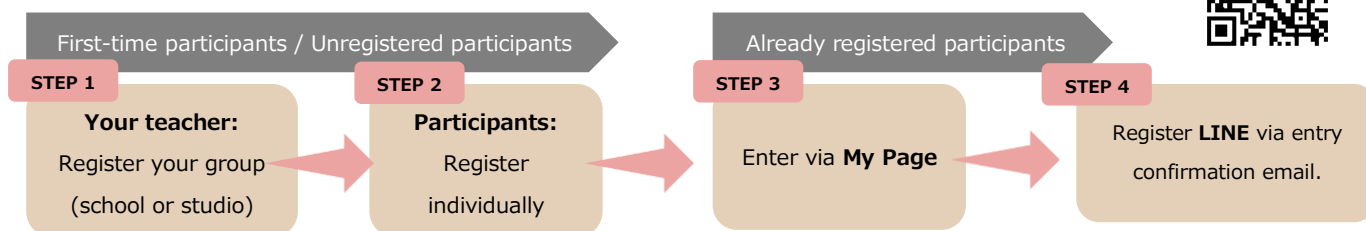

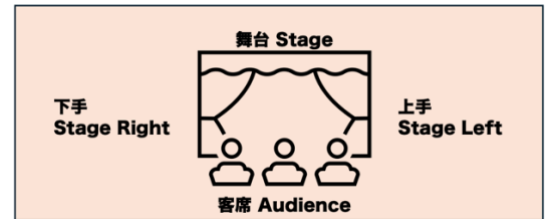

<About entry>

- Nationality and gender are not a concern.
- Entries can be made in multiple categories , with a maximum of 1 entry in the same category.

<About the stage>

- The size of Culttz Kawasaki's stage is 18 m wide x 16 m deep.
- The floor is linoleum, the background is a horizontal curtain , and the lighting is simple lighting, which cannot be changed.



<About Performance>

- Costumes and stage makeup will be ok.
- Props and other items used must be brought in and out by yourself and may only be used during performance time. It is not allowed to take out equipment before the performance, but it is allowed when you are on the stage. Be sure to take it with you when you are off from stage. Items that may contaminate the venue are not allowed.
- It is prohibited to raise your voice on stage during the performance.
- If there is a copyright to the music and choreography other than the contemporary dance repertoire , or the choreography of the classical ballet solo repertoire, participants must obtain permission to use it. If copyright-related costs are incurred, participants will be billed later.
- Please to be on stage within 10 seconds after the announcement ends.
- After performing, please get off from stage within 10 seconds of the end of the music. Reverence (bowing) may or may not be done on the spot. Once you enter the curtain, you cannot exit again due to Reverence.
- If you drop or leave something on the stage, even if it is unintentional, please report it immediately. Performers will not be allowed to return to the stage.
- Tap shoes, flamenco shoes, etc. that may damage the floor are not allowed.

Points will be deducted • If you exceed the time limit before and after your performance (within 10 seconds each), your points will be deducted.

Disqualification • If you exceed the performance time, violate the regulations, or obstruct the progress of the stage, you will be disqualified.

<About the review>

- Using a unique scoring system, we will judge technicality , artistry , musicality, expressiveness, etc.
 - Preliminaries: There will be no preliminaries for all divisions in 2026.
 - Final: The first round will be evaluation by variation.
 - * The second round will be a public lesson or an enchainement. Details will be communicated to those who pass.

While there is no final concert performance, students can observe other classes on designated days and will receive complimentary parent-child tickets for the Gala Concert.
